

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- A completed Warner Pacific College **Application for Admission** including a signed Community Covenant.
- A **\$50.00 non-refundable application fee**. The application fee may be waived by submission of one of the following: a College Examination Board Waiver Form or a letter requesting waiver from a high school guidance counselor.
- A **Personal Essay**, 1-2 pages typed, describing your educational and career goals and how Warner Pacific College will help you reach them.
- An **official high school transcript** sent directly from the school or test scores from the General Education Development Test (GED) are required for all applicants to the freshman class and transfer students with less than 20 semester credits. Home schooled students are also required to submit a home school supplement form and a transcript or academic record (on a 4.0 GPA scale) of any of their coursework completed at a high school.
- Official examination scores** from the Scholastic Assessment Test of the College Examination Board (SAT) or American College Testing Program Assessment (ACT) are required of all applicants to the freshman class and transfer students who have earned less than 20 semester hours of college credit. If five or more years have passed since high school graduation, this requirement may not be applicable. Warner Pacific College's SAT college code number, 4595, should be placed on the examination for the official reporting of the scores. The ACT college code number is 3486.

- An **official transcript from each college and university attended** sent directly from the institution to the Warner Pacific College Office of Admissions.
- A **personal interview** and/or **references** may be required of selected students.
