### **TALENT AWARDS\***

For First-Time Freshman and Transfers involved in Athletics, Music or Drama.

**VALUE:** Varies

**REQUIREMENTS:** Minimum 2.50 (4.00 scale) high school GPA or 2.0 college GPA and demonstrated talent.

### **CHURCH OF GOD GRANT**

For First-Time Freshman and Transfers attending the Church of God, Anderson, IN.

**VALUE:** Up to \$1,000 each year (renewable for 3 additional years)

**REQUIREMENTS:** Minimum 2.50 (4.00 scale) high school GPA or 2.0 college GPA and documented church attendance via a letter from the church pastor.

### **ALUMNI GRANT\***

For First-Time Freshman and Transfers whose parent attended WPC for 30 or more semester hours.

**VALUE:** Up to \$500 each year (renewable for 3 additional years)

**REQUIREMENTS:** Minimum 2.50 (4.00 scale) high school GPA or 2.0 college GPA.

### **CHURCH MATCHING GRANT**

Warner Pacific College will match church contributions toward education.

**VALUE:** Up to \$500 each semester

**REQUIREMENTS:** Minimum 2.00 GPA and church contribution.

### **INTERNATIONAL STUDENT GRANT**

For First-Time Freshman and Transfers who are International Students (non-US citizens/non-residents).

**VALUE:** Up to \$1500 each year (renewable for 3 additional years)

**REQUIREMENTS:** Minimum 2.00 GPA

\* Requires separate application, interview/audition

## SECTION 3 - CERTIFICATION OF FUNDS

The following letters and documents must be received by the Warner Pacific Admissions Office before the applicant can be admitted.

**A. Support provided from the applicant's personal funds must be declared in:**

- 1) A personal notarized letter from the applicant. The letter must include the following information: the amount of funds in U.S. dollars in your personal savings account(s), the name of the school you will attend (Warner Pacific College), your personal signature, and the signature and official seal of a Notary Public, lawyer or other public official.
- 2) An official letter/form from your bank(s) signed and sealed by a bank official stating the following: the date your account was opened, the average monthly balance during the past year in U.S. dollars, and the current balance in U.S. dollars.

**B. EACH family/personal sponsor for the applicant must send:**

- 1) A personal letter verifying his/her intention to provide support for the applicant. This letter **MUST** be officially witnessed by a Notary Public, lawyer or other public official and personally signed by the sponsor. This letter **MUST** include the following statement: "I accept personal responsibility to provide funds in the amount of U.S. \$\_\_\_\_\_ per year to support (Name of Applicant) at Warner Pacific College until the date \_\_\_\_\_. My total resources available for the applicant are U.S. \$\_\_\_\_\_."
- 2) An official letter/form from the bank in which the sponsor has a current account. This letter must be written on bank stationery and include the following items: the name of the account holder, the date the account was opened, the average monthly balance of the account during the past year, and signature and seal of a bank official.
- 3) If employed, a statement from the employer indicating: the starting date of employment, the nature or title of the employment, salary range, and whether the employment is temporary or permanent. (If self-employed and a U.S. permanent resident or citizen, attach a copy of the last income tax return or report of commercial rating concern.)

**C. Church sponsors must verify their support of the applicant with:**

- 1) A letter stating: the name of the applicant, the name of the school the applicant will attend while receiving funds, the amount of funds and length of time the funds will be available to the applicant, and the personal signature of the church's pastor and/or treasurer.

- 2) A statement(s) from the bank in which the church has a current account. The letter must be written on bank stationery and include the following: the name of the account holder, the date the account was opened, the average monthly balance of the account during the past year, and signature and seal of a bank official.

**D. Scholarships, grants, or loans from a public institution, organization, or foundation may be verified with a letter from the source of the funds. The letter must be on official stationery. It must contain the following information: the name of the applicant for whom the funds are intended, the name of the school the applicant will attend while receiving the funds, the amount of funds available to the applicant, the length of time for which the applicant will receive the funds, and the personal signature of the institution or organization. The application for admission will not be processed until all the sections are completed and properly witnessed, and all supporting documents and letters are received.**
