### BASIC COURSES REQUIRED OF ALL DEGREES

(For students transferring to Warner Pacific without an Associate of Arts Oregon Transfer Degree)

**Warner Pacific Requirements: a minimum of 42 semester/63 quarter credits from the following categories**

<b>COMMUNICATIONS:</b> Three courses, including one full year of college composition.	WR 121 and 122 and 123 or WR 121 & 122 if taken for 4 cr. plus an additional writing course at Warner Pacific	8-9
<b>HUMANITIES:</b> Five courses. Freshman and Sophomore transfers w/ (less than 90 qtr hours) complete 2 courses in 2 areas of History, Literature and/or Philosophy, plus 3 Humanities courses at WPC.  Junior transfers w/ (90 qtr hours or more) complete 3 courses in 2 areas of History, Literature, and/or Philosophy, plus 2 Humanities courses at WPC.	Any HST, PHL, or Literature (ENG prefix) course (2-3 courses in two areas. See requirements in left column)	8-12
<b>RELIGION:</b> Freshman and Sophomore transfers complete 3 identified courses. Junior transfers complete 2 courses. At least one additional religion course will be taken while attending Warner Pacific	ENG 275 <u>May not duplicate coursework taken to satisfy Humanities requirements.</u>	4-8
<b>MATHEMATICS:</b> One course MTH 100 or higher.	Choose one course from MTH 100 or higher.	4-5
<b>SCIENCE:</b> One course, with regular lab experience	Any Science course with accompanying lab. (Need not be a series)	4-5
<b>SOCIAL SCIENCE:</b> Two courses from 2 different areas.	2 courses from 2 different areas: ANTH, EC, GEO, PS, PSY, SOC	8
<b>HEALTH/ PHYSICAL EDUCATION:</b> One Health/Wellness course, plus two PE experiences.	HE 250 plus two PE experiences or HPE 295 plus one PE experience.	4-5
<b>FINE ARTS:</b> Four semester credits from Art, Drama, Fine Arts or Music. One course chosen must emphasize the cultural/historical aspects of the art form. Additional course(s) must be participatory or performance oriented.	Choose at least one course from: <b>ART</b> 101, 102, 103, 204, 205, 206, 207, 208, 209, 210, 211, 212, 213, 276; <b>ENG</b> 105; <b>MUS</b> 105, 106, 201A, 202, 203, 205, 206, 207, 208, 209, 210; <b>TA</b> 101  Additional credits may come from any ART, MUS or TA course	6 cr minimum

**PCC DEGREE/TRANSFER INFORMATION:**

**Associate of Arts/Oregon Transfer (AAOT) Degree** – The courses listed above may be included in the AAOT degree. The degree will be accepted as having met all core studies requirements except for Religion, upper-division Humanities courses, and a third writing course (if WR 121 and 122 are taken for four credits).

**Associate of Science (AS) Degree** – The courses listed above may be included in the AS degree. The degree does NOT guarantee that students will be accepted as having completed all lower division comprehensive and General Education requirements for a baccalaureate degree. Student should work with an Academic Advisor to plan for transfer to the school and major of their choice.

**Transfer without a PCC Degree** – Students may elect to earn credits and transfer to a four-year institution without earning a PCC degree. Please meet with an Academic Advisor for an individualized plan of study.
