- Warner Pacific College will compare information on this worksheet and any supporting documents with the information you submitted on your FAFSA. Corrections may be made by the College.
- Warner Pacific College may require additional documentation if we have reason to believe that the information provided is inaccurate.

The Department of Education is encouraging all FAFSA filers to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to complete the tax return information on the FAFSA in 2014-2015. The IRS Data Retrieval Tool is available for those who qualify at www.fafsa.gov about 2 weeks after electronically filing your 2013 tax return or 8 weeks if filing by paper.

You cannot use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool if any of the following apply. You must submit an IRS Tax Return Transcript to our office instead:

- 1. Individual filed a joint tax return but now is separated, divorced, widowed or married to another individual.
- 2. Individual is married but filed a separate tax return from their spouse.
- Individual used the IRS Data Retrieval Tool, but needed to change the information. 3.

- 4. Individual filed a Non-IRS Tax Return (Foreign or Territory). Submit a copy of that tax form signed by the tax payer.
- Individual was granted a filing extension from the IRS. Submit a copy of your IRS Form 4868 and all W2s received and/or a profit and loss statement (if self-employed).
