

APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Warner Pacific College selects candidates for admission who value a Christian liberal arts education and provide evidence of academic achievement, aptitude, and the ability to benefit from and contribute to the opportunities offered at the College. Freshman applicants and transfer students with less than 12 semester credits are required to display a minimum 2.50 cumulative high school GPA (4.0 scale) and a minimum combined SAT score of 910 (1600 scale in critical reading and math) or ACT composite score of 19 (36 scale). Transfer students with more than 12 semester credits are required to have a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative college GPA (4.0 scale).

Each candidate for admission is reviewed individually with careful consideration given to academic records, test scores, application essay, and the ability to benefit from and contribute to the opportunities offered at the College. Warner Pacific College complies with federal and state requirements for non-discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, age, sex, gender, sexual orientation (including gender identity), disability, veteran status or any legally protected status in admission and access to its programs and activities. Warner Pacific College reserves the right to deny admission to any applicant when that decision is determined to be in the best interest of the student or the institution.

When to Apply

For Fall semester, Warner Pacific College has a priority application deadline for freshmen of January 31. The priority application deadline for transfer students is March 15. Applications are also accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year.

Students are encouraged to apply for admission at the earliest possible date. An early application for admission provides optimal opportunity for financial aid awards, course selection, and campus housing. Applications for the spring and summer semesters are accepted on a rolling basis.

Home School Students

Home School students are required to submit the Traditional Application for Admission and the Home Schooled Student Application Supplement.

International Students

International Students may apply by completing the International Student Application for Admission and the International Student Financial Verification Form.

Non-Degree Seeking Students

Students who are not seeking a degree or are enrolled in another institution and wish to take courses from Warner Pacific College may apply via the Non-Degree Seeking Student Application for Admission. Students who wish to maintain non-degree seeking student status may accumulate up to 15 credits at Warner Pacific College while enrolling in no more than 5 credits at one time.

Re-Admit Students

Former Warner Pacific College students who have withdrawn from the College or have failed to maintain continuous enrollment may apply for re-admission by completing the Re-Admit Application. Students who have filed a Leave of Absence Form with the Records Office and return at the prescribed time are not required to apply for re-admission.
