Eligibility

Applicants for the Departmental Scholarships must:

1. Be a WPC undergraduate students continuing from the previous academic year with sophomore, junior or senior standing in the upcoming academic year
2. Be registered for the next academic year as a full time student in the traditional program (at least 12 or more credits for the fall and spring semesters)
3. Be majoring in one of the majors within that department
4. Be in good academic standing with a minimum 3.00 (4.00 scale) cumulative college GPA
5. Have demonstrated financial need

Application Process

1. For information or to request an application, contact the Department Chair, the Office of Student Financial Services, or access the Financial Aid section of the Warner Pacific website.
2. Complete the enclosed application.
3. Applicants must complete the scholarship application process by 5:00 PM on March 16, 2015.
4. The completed application must be submitted to the Faculty Office Assistant in A.F. Gray Room # 315, no later than 5:00 PM, March 16, 2015.
5. Once received, all applications will be reviewed by the department scholarship selection committee. Subsequently, eligible students will be informed of their eligibility to continue in the process.
6. Interviews will be scheduled with the individual committees after March 16, 2015.
7. Selection is based on scholastic achievement and the potential for contribution to the individual department. Demonstrated financial need is a consideration.

Re-application is required to be considered for future awards.

Re-application

To be considered for a scholarship renewal, the application process must be completed each year. Applicants may re-apply for the scholarship provided they continue to major in a program offered by the Education Department, actively participate in Department activities, fulfill eight hours of departmental service per semester, maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA, and are enrolled full-time.

Scholarship Information:

Humanities Departmental

The Humanities Departmental Scholarship is a scholarship of up to \$2,000 available to continuing undergraduate students majoring in one of the Humanities fields: American Studies, Communications, English, History, History & Social Studies, or Liberal Studies; or students minoring in American Studies, Communications, English, History, Fine Arts, Philosophy, or Drama. The scholarship recognizes outstanding scholastic achievement, potential for further study, and significant contributions to the department. This is an annual scholarship. Re-application is required to be considered for future awards.

Re-application

A student may re-apply for the scholarship annually, provided the recipient continues to major or minor in a program offered by the Humanities department, makes satisfactory progress toward a degree with a major or minor in a Humanities field, fulfills eight hours of departmental service per semester, is active in selected department activities/events, maintains a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA, and is enrolled full time. Departmental service consists of such things as leafleting/advertising Humanities functions and productions, helping organize the annual Humanities Receptions, cataloging/collating departmental assessment data, and/or assisting the Department Chair with other Humanities activities and related work.

Students re-applying for the scholarship must complete the following:

Submit a one-page statement accounting for the eight hours of departmental service per semester completed during fall semester and in process during spring semester. This must be submitted to the Humanities Department Chair during the second week of March.

In cases of re-application, the Humanities Department will meet following spring break to review the student's fall semester final grades and spring semester midterm grades to determine that a 3.00 GPA has been maintained and that progress toward a Humanities degree or minor continues. The committee will make recommendations concerning scholarship awards. The Humanities Department Chair will contact the student personally to announce the decision of the committee.

Natural Sciences & Health Departmental

The Natural Sciences and Health Departmental Scholarship is a scholarship of up to \$2,000 available to continuing WPC undergraduate students majoring in one of the Natural Sciences and Health fields: Biological Science: General Biology Emphasis, Biological Science: Human Biology Emphasis, Health & Human Kinetics, Health Sciences, Sports & Recreation Management or Physical Science. The scholarship recognizes outstanding scholastic achievement, potential for further study, and significant contributions to the department. This is an annual scholarship. Re-application is required to be considered for future awards.

Re-application

To be considered for a scholarship renewal, the application process must be completed each year.

Applicants may re-apply for the scholarship provided they continue to major in a program offered by the Natural Sciences and Health Department, actively participate in Department activities, fulfill ten hours of departmental service per semester, maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA, maintain a minimum 3.25 GPA within the major, and are enrolled full-time.

Religion & Christian Ministries Departmental

The Religion and Christian Ministries Departmental Scholarship is a scholarship of up to \$3,000 available to continuing WPC undergraduate students majoring within the Religion and Christian Ministries Department. The scholarship recognizes outstanding scholastic achievement and successful mentoring as well as potential for further study and contribution to the department. This is an annual scholarship. Re-application is required to be considered for future awards.

Re-application

The scholarship may be renewable upon reapplication. Students apply for one year at a time. Recipients are expected to continue to major in a program offered by the department, make satisfactory progress toward a degree in Christian Ministries or Music and Youth Ministries, fulfill eight hours of departmental service per semester, be active in selected department activities/events, maintain a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA, and be enrolled full-time. Departmental service consists of such things as leafleting/advertising Religion and Christian Ministries functions, coordinating communication with other students in the department, helping organize intra-departmental events and CM 400 nights of stories, cataloging/collating departmental assessment data, and/or assisting the Department Chair with other Religion and Christian Ministries activities and related work.

The Charles Nielsen Social Science Departmental

The Social Science Departmental Scholarship is a scholarship of up to \$1,000 available to continuing WPC undergraduate students majoring in one of the Social Science fields. The scholarship recognizes outstanding scholastic achievement as well as potential for further study and contribution to the department. This is an annual scholarship. Re-application is required to be considered for future awards.

Re-application

To be considered for a scholarship renewal, the application process must be completed each year. Applicants may re-apply for the scholarship provided they continue to major in a program offered by the Social Science Department, actively participate in Social Science Department activities, fulfill ten hours of departmental service per semester, maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA, and are enrolled full-time.

Departmental Expectations for Students Receiving the Scholarship

Students receiving this scholarship will be asked to fulfill up to 10 hours of departmental service per semester. Departmental service consists of such things as leafleting/advertising Social Science functions, helping organize the semi-annual Internship Reception, cataloging/collating departmental assessment data, and/or assisting members of the department with other Social Science activities and related work.

At the end of the academic year, each awardee will be asked to submit a one-page statement accounting for the hours of departmental service completed for both the fall and spring semesters. This statement must be submitted to the Social Science Department Chair during the final week of classes.
