CORE STUDIES REQUIREMENTS for CHEMEKETA C.C. TRANSFERS
COURSES REQUIRED FOR ALL BACHELOR DEGREES

(For students transferring to Warner Pacific without an Associate of Arts OTD)

Warner Pacific Requirements: a minimum of 42 semester/63 quarter credits from the following categories:

| COMMUNICATIONS: Three courses, including one full year of college composition. | WR 121, 122. NOTE: EN 200 will need to be completed at WPC to complete the series. | 8 |

Freshman and Sophomore transfers (w/ fewer than 90 transferable qtr credits) complete 2 courses in 2 areas of History, Literature and/or Philosophy, plus 3 Humanities courses at WPC. Junior transfers w/ (90 transferable qtr credits or more) complete 3 courses in 2 areas of History, Literature, and/or Philosophy, plus 2 Humanities courses at WP | 2-3 HST, PHL, ENG course | 8-12 |
| RELIGION: Freshman and Sophomore transfers complete 2 courses; Juniors complete 1 course. One additional Religion course will be required in residence at Warner Pacific. | Freshman/Sophomore transfers: REL 160, ENG 275. Junior transfers: REL 160 <u>May not duplicate coursework taken to satisfy Humanities requirements.</u> | 4-8 |
| MATHEMATICS: One college-level course. | Choose one course from MTH 105 or higher. | 4-5 |
| NATURAL SCIENCE: One course, with regular lab experience | Any Natural Science course with accompanying lab. (BIO, PHS, CHM) | 4-5 |
| SOCIAL SCIENCE: Two courses from 2 different areas. | 2 courses from 2 different areas: ATH, EC, GEG, HDF, PS, PSY, SOC, SSC | 8-10 |
| FINE ARTS: Four semester credits from Art, Drama, Fine Arts or Music. One course chosen must emphasize the cultural/historical aspects of the art form. Additional course(s) must be participatory or performance oriented. | One course from: ART 101-118, 201-210, 289; FA 255-257; MUS 105, 161, 201-203 Remaining credits may be selected from: ART 131-156, 221-254, 261-286, 291-293; FLM 265-267; MUS 111-113, 197 | 6 cr minimum |
| HEALTH/ PHYSICAL EDUCATION: One Health/Wellness course, plus two PE experiences. | HLTH 250 or HPE 295, plus 2 different PE activities, | 4-5 |

Courses may be applied toward only one area of WP Core Studies. The term "course" as used in the above categories (with the exception of Fine Arts and Physical Education) is defined as a class of one term's duration, carrying at least three (3) quarter credits.

CCC DEGREE/TRANSFER INFORMATION:

Associate of Arts/Oregon Transfer Degree (AA-OTD) – The courses listed above may be included in the AA-OTD. The degree will be accepted has having met most core studies requirements except for 2-3 Humanities courses and 1-2 Religion courses, all of which must be taken at WP. Students completing the AA-OTD must still meet the writing and math requirements for WP baccalaureate degree candidates.

Associate of Science (AS) or Associate of Applied Science (AAS) Degree – The courses listed above may be included in the AS or AAS degree programs. Completion of the degree does NOT guarantee that students will be accepted as having fulfilled all lower division comprehensive and Core Studies requirements for a baccalaureate degree. Student should work with an Academic Advisor to plan for transfer to the school and major of their choice.

Transfer without a CCC Degree – Students may elect to earn credits and transfer to Warner Pacific without earning a CCC degree. Please meet with an Academic Advisor for an individualized plan of study.
