

WARNER PACIFIC CORE STUDIES REQUIREMENTS for SEATTLE COLLEGE TRANSFERS

BASIC COURSES REQUIRED OF ALL BACHELOR DEGREES

(For students transferring to Warner Pacific without an Associate of Arts)

Warner Pacific Requirements: a minimum of 42 semester/63 quarter credits from the following categories

COMMUNICATIONS: Three courses, including one full year of college composition.	ENGL 101 & 102 plus other Writing, Journalism, Communication or Speech class.	5-15
HUMANITIES: Five courses. Freshman and Sophomore transfers w/ (less than 90 qtr hours) complete 2 courses in 2 areas of History, Literature and/or Philosophy, plus 3 Humanities courses at WP. Junior transfers w/ (90 qtr hours or more) complete 3 courses in 2 areas of History, Literature, and/or Philosophy, plus 2 Humanities courses at WP.	Any HST, PHL, or Literature (ENG prefix) course (2-3 courses in two areas. See requirements in left column)	15
RELIGION: Freshman and Sophomore transfers complete 3 identified courses. Junior transfers complete 2 courses. At least one additional religion course will be taken while attending Warner Pacific	N/A	0
MATHEMATICS: One course MTH 100 or higher.	Choose one course from MATH 100 or higher.	5
NATURAL SCIENCE: One course, with regular lab experience	Any Science course with accompanying lab. (Need not be a series) (BIO, CHM, PHS)	5
SOCIAL SCIENCE: Two courses from 2 different areas.	2 courses from 2 different areas: ANTH, EC, GEO, PS, PSY, SOC	10
HEALTH/ PHYSICAL EDUCATION: One Health/Wellness course, plus two PE experiences.	HLTH 130 plus two PE experiences	4-6
FINE ARTS: Four semester credits from Art, Drama, Fine Arts or Music. One course chosen must emphasize the cultural/historical aspects of the art form. Additional course(s) must be participatory or performance oriented.	One Cultural/historical course in ART, MUS or TA One activity course from any ART, MUS or TA course	6 cr minimum

Courses may be applied toward only one area of WP Core Studies. The term "course" as used in the above categories (with the exception of Fine Arts and Physical Education) is defined as a class of one term's duration, carrying at least three (3) quarter credits.

SEATTLE COLLEGE DEGREE/TRANSFER INFORMATION:

Associate of Arts (AA), Associate of Science (AS) or Associate of Applied Science (AAS) Degree – The courses listed above may be included in the AS or AAS degree programs. Completion of the degree does NOT guarantee that students will be accepted as having fulfilled all lower division comprehensive and Core Studies requirements for a baccalaureate degree. Student should work with an Academic Advisor to plan for transfer to the school and major of their choice.

Transfer without a Degree – Students may elect to earn credits and transfer to Warner Pacific without earning a degree. Please meet with an Academic Advisor for an individualized plan of study.
