### BASIC COURSES REQUIRED OF ALL BACHELOR DEGREES

*(For students transferring to Warner Pacific without an Associate of Arts DTA)*

**Warner Pacific Requirements: a minimum of 42 semester/63 quarter credits from the following categories:**

Junior transfers w/ ( <b>90 qtr hours or more</b> ) <b>complete 3 courses in 2 areas</b> of History, Literature, and/or Philosophy, plus 2 Humanities courses at WPC	Any HIST, PHIL course; ENGL 130-159, 260-272; HUM 101, 112, 180. (2-3 courses in two areas.)	6-15
<b>RELIGION:</b> Freshman and Sophomore transfers complete 2; Juniors complete 1 course. One additional Religion course will be taken while attending Warner Pacific	Choose from: ENGL 152 (freshman or sophomore only) <u>May not duplicate coursework taken to satisfy Communications or Humanities requirements.</u>	3-10
<b>MATHEMATICS:</b> One course College Algebra or higher.	Choose one course from MATH 111 or higher.	3-5
<b>NATURAL SCIENCE:</b> One course, with regular lab experience	Any NATURAL Science course with accompanying lab(BIO, CHM, PHS)	4-5
<b>SOCIAL SCIENCE:</b> Two courses from 2 different areas.	2 courses from 2 different areas: ANTH, ECON, GEOG, POSC, PSYC, SOC	6-10
<b>FINE ARTS:</b> Four semester credits from Art, Drama, Fine Arts or Music. One course chosen must emphasize the cultural/historical aspects of the art form. Additional course(s) must be participatory or performance oriented.	One course from: ART 151, 220-250; ENGL 132; HUM 102, 103, 152; MUS 127-135; THEA 105. Remaining credits may be selected from: ART 103-146, 168-170, 175-191, 203-207, 257-262; ENGL 121-123; MUS 101-125, 137-297; THEA 140-173, 243-273.	6 cr minimum
<b>HEALTH/ PHYSICAL EDUCATION:</b> One Health/Wellness course, plus two PE experiences.	HLTH 101 plus 2 PE activities, or HPE 258 plus 1 PE activity	4-5

*Courses may be applied toward only one area of WPC Core Studies. The term "course" as used in the above categories (with the exception of Fine Arts and Physical Education) is defined as a class of one term's duration, carrying at least three (3) quarter credits.*

#### **CC DEGREE/TRANSFER INFORMATION:**

**Associate of Arts/Direct Transfer Agreement (DTA)** – The courses listed above may be included in the DTA degree. The degree will be accepted has having met all core studies requirements except for 2-3 Humanities courses and 1-2 Religion courses, all of which must be taken at WPC..

**Associate of Science (AS) or Associate of Applied Science (AAS) Degree** – The courses listed above may be included in the AS or AAS degree programs. Completion of the degree does NOT guarantee that students will be accepted as having fulfilled all lower division comprehensive and Core Studies requirements for a baccalaureate degree. Student should work with an Academic Advisor to plan for transfer to the school and major of their choice.

**Transfer without a CC Degree** – Students may elect to earn credits and transfer to Warner Pacific without earning a CC degree. Please meet with an Academic Advisor for an individualized plan of study.
