LANE DEGREE/TRANSFER INFORMATION:

Associate of Arts/Oregon Transfer (AAOT) Degree – The courses listed above may be included in the AAOT degree. The degree will be accepted has having met all core studies requirements except for Religion, upper-division Humanities courses, and a third writing course (if WR 121 and 122 are taken for four credits).

Associate of Science (AS) Degree – The courses listed above may be included in the AS degree. The degree does NOT guarantee that students will be accepted as having completed all lower division comprehensive and General Education requirements for a baccalaureate degree. Student should work with an Academic Advisor to plan for transfer to the school and major of their choice.

Transfer without a Lane Degree – Students may elect to earn credits and transfer to a four-year institution without earning a Lane degree. Please meet with an Academic Advisor for an individualized plan of study.
