Courses may be applied toward only one area of general education core. Courses applied towards major/minor may not also count towards core, except for Ethics. The term "course" as used in the above categories (with the exception of Fine Arts and Physical Education) is defined as a class of one term's duration, carrying at least three (3) quarter credits and numbered 100 or above unless specified otherwise. CWE and vocational/technical credits may not be applied toward Core Studies requirements.

Students having completed an associate degree will be admitted with junior status. All transfer students must complete EN 200, HUM 310 and REL 320 at Warner Pacific University. College-level mathematics coursework or proficiency is also required. Other requirements may apply.
