Courses may be applied toward only one area of general education core. Courses applied towards major/minor may not also count towards core, except for Ethics. The term "course" as used in the above categories (with the exception of Fine Arts and Physical Education) is defined as a class of one term's duration, carrying at least three (3) quarter credits and numbered 100 or above unless specified otherwise. CWE and vocational/technical credits may not be applied toward Core Studies requirements.

MT. HOOD COMMUNITY COLLEGE DEGREE/TRANSFER INFORMATION:

Associate of Applied Science (AAS) Degree – Completion of the AAS does NOT guarantee fulfillment of all lower division Core Studies requirements for a Warner Pacific baccalaureate degree. Having completed an associate degree does qualify a student to be admitted with junior status. The student should work with an Academic Advisor to plan for transfer to the school and major of their choice.

Associate of Arts/Oregon Transfer Degree (AAOT) –The degree will be accepted as having met all core studies requirements except for HUM 310/410, REL 220/320, and EN 200. College-level mathematics coursework or proficiency is also required.

Transfer without a Degree – Students may elect to earn credits and transfer to Warner Pacific without earning an associate degree. Please meet with an Academic Advisor for an individualized plan of study.
