Greetings from Warner Pacific University! We invite you to attend our annual High School Symphonic Band Festival which will be held this Spring on **Friday March 6, 2020**. The format will include the traditional thirty minutes in the warm-up room, thirty minutes on stage for performance, and thirty minutes in the sight-reading room. The OBDA form will be used and bands that reach the required score for their school size/category will be able to qualify for the OSAA State Band Contest recording pool. Participating bands will also receive a recording of their performance, taped comments from our adjudicators, and a short, on stage, clinic. I am proud to announce that our judges this year will be Pat Vandehey, Chuck Bolton, Dave Becker, and Dave Matthys (sight reading)

The fee for this event will be **\$350** for applications received **postmarked by Friday, Dec. 1**, **\$375 for those received postmarked by Jan. 12**. Time preference for each band will be based on the order in which the applications are received and only 14 bands will be accepted. The purpose of our festival is to create a positive environment where students can appreciate the experience of performing music for one another so we encourage you to stay and listen to a few groups.

We take pride in running an effective band festival, with a positive atmosphere, quality judges, and well-organized agenda. We appreciate your commitment to the arts and would encourage your participation in this event.
