<b>Scientific Reasoning / Knowledge</b>	ESR 171-173, or choose a course from the following departments: BI, CH, G or PHY	3 credit minimum
<b>Quantitative Reasoning</b>	MTH 105 or higher	3 credit minimum
<b>Historical/Cultural Knowledge and Practice</b>	ED 112, WR 239-249 or any course from the following departments: ART, D, ENG, HST, MUC, MUP, MUS or TA	3 credit minimum
<b>Critical Thinking and Strategic Action</b>	Choose from the following departments: COMM, EC, or PHL	3 credit minimum

Courses may be applied toward only one area of general education core. The term "course" as used in the above categories (with the exception of Fine Arts and Physical Education) is defined as a class of one term's duration, carrying at least three (3) quarter credits and numbered 100 or above unless specified otherwise. CWE and vocational/technical credits may not be applied toward Core Studies requirements.



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### **PORTLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE DEGREE/TRANSFER INFORMATION:**

**Associate of Art Oregon Transfer Degree (AAOT) and Associate of Science Oregon Transfer Degree (ASOT)** – The AAOT and ASOT degrees will be accepted as having met all core studies requirements except for the three advanced-level core course requirements (REL 220 or 320, ILR 300, and HUM 310 or 410).

**Other Associate Degree** – Completion of another associate degree (such as the AS, AST, AAS, AAST, or AGS) does not guarantee fulfillment of all lower division Core Studies requirements for a Warner Pacific baccalaureate degree. The transcript will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis using course equivalency chart. Having completed an associate degree does qualify a student to be admitted with junior status. The student should work with an Academic Advisor to plan for transfer to the school and major of their choice.

**Transfer without a Degree** – Students may elect to earn credits and transfer to Warner Pacific without earning an associate degree. Please meet with an Academic Advisor for an individualized plan of study.
