Transfer Guide for Clackamas Community College



Transfer Associate Degrees: The AAOT (Associate of Art Oregon Transfer Degree) and ASOT (Associate of Science Oregon Transfer Degree) degrees will be accepted as having met all lower-division core studies requirements for a baccalaureate degree. Students will still take the three advanced-level core requirements (REL 320, ILR 300, and HUM 310) after transferring to Warner Pacific University.

Other Associate Degrees or Transfer without a Degree: Students who transfer with another associate degree (such as the AS, AST, AAS, AAST, or AGS) or who transfer without a degree will have their transcript evaluated on a course-by-course basis for using the general education core course equivalency chart.

General Education Core Course Transfer Equivalency Chart

All core courses must be completed at the college level with a grade of C- or higher. Any one course may be applied toward only one area of the core. Vocational/technical credits may not be applied toward core.

Critical Thinking & Strategic Action (1 course)	Take one course from the following departments: Communication, Economics, or Philosophy	3 credit minimum
Holistic World View (1 Health + 1 PE course)	HPE 295, R 204, R211 or R212 FN 110, FN 225, HE 204, HD 223, or HPE 296 PLUS One activity course chosen from Physical Education (PE 185)	3 credit minimum
Ethics (1 course)	PHL 102	3 credit minimum
Appreciation of Diversity (1 course)	ANT 103, ANT 231-232, COMM 140, GEOG 110, or take a foreign language course (ASL, FR, GER, SPA)	3 credit minimum
Urban Life (1 course)	PS 201, PSY 101-205, SOC 204-206, or SOC 225	3 credit minimum

General Education Core Courses Completed at Warner Pacific University

All students will complete 3 advanced-level general education core courses at WPU: ILR 300 Advanced Information Literacy & Research, HUM 310 Faith, Living, and Learning, and REL 320: Spirituality, Character, and Service.
