Transfer Guide for Lower Columbia College

Transfer Associate Degrees: The DTA (Associate of Arts/Direct Transfer Agreement) degree will be accepted as having met all lower-division core studies requirements for a baccalaureate degree. Students will still take the three advanced-level core requirements (REL 320, ILR 300, and HUM 310) after transferring to Warner Pacific University.

Other Associate Degrees or Transfer without a Degree: Students who transfer with another associate degree (such as the AS, AST, AAS, AAST, or AGS) or who transfer without a degree will have their transcript evaluated on a course-bycourse basis for using the general education core course equivalency chart.

General Education Core Course Transfer Equivalency Chart

All core courses must be completed at the college level with a grade of C- or higher. Any <u>one</u> course may be applied toward only <u>one</u> area of the core. Vocational/technical credits may not be applied toward core.
