Courses You Should Take at Clark College

Total Credits & GPA

Complete at least 90 quarter credits (60 semester credits) of transferrable coursework. A minimum cumulative college GPA of 2.5 is required.

Science Prerequisite Courses for BSN Program

Science prerequisite courses must be completed within the past seven years with a minimum grade of C- on each course. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required for these science courses. For courses taken more than once in the past seven years, the higher grade of the first two attempts will be used in the science GPA calculation.

BSN Prerequisite Requirement

- Human A&P Sequence with Lab (1 year)
- Microbiology with Lab (1 course)
- Chemistry with Lab (1 course)

Students admitted to the BSN program at Warner Pacific University complete of 62 credits over the span of 4 semesters (2 years). The requirements include 53 credits of Nursing coursework and 9 credits of baccalaureate-level core coursework (ILR 300 Advanced Information Literacy & Research, HUM 310 Faith, Living, and Learning, and REL 320 Spirituality, Character, and Service).
