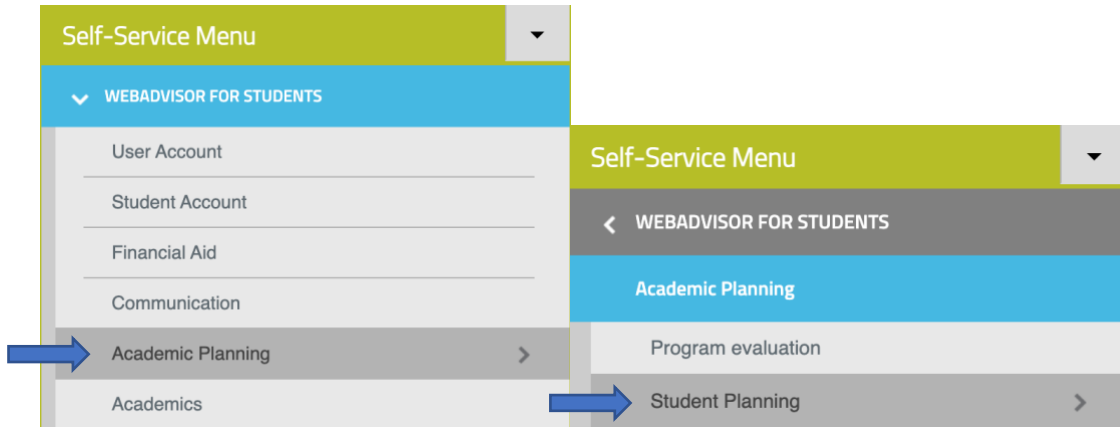


My Progress

The 'My Progress' page is a helpful tool in determining where you are in your degree and what you still need to accomplish.

To access this tool go to MyWP and find the Self-Service Menu. Click on 'Academic Planning', and then 'Student Planning'.
