


May 8 Commencement Stage Walk: Event Map & Instructions



We are so excited to celebrate with you! Here are some basic instructions regarding the May 8 event:

- > Please park in one of the main parking lots along Division Street.
- The event walking route involves slopes and stairs. The Accessibility Drop Off & Pick Up Zone (in yellow) is located along 68th Avenue for any members of your party who need it. Sidewalks flank the main lawn (indicated in yellow on the map) and provide access to the General Viewing and Priority Viewing areas.
- > Please enter the event on foot via the sidewalks along 68th Avenue.
- Each student should check in (red star on map) at your assigned start time. You will be given additional instructions at check in.
- You and your guests may use the general viewing area (lawn standing area) to watch your classmates walk across the stage. In order to help us maintain appropriate capacity per pandemic guidelines, we suggest each student limit their time in the general viewing area to 10-15 minutes.
- > Your personal guests may use the Priority Viewing area for your personal stage walk.
- > Please exit the event using the stairs between Egtvedt and the Gymnasium.
- You and your guests may take photos at various outdoor locations on campus either before or after your stage walk. Some suggested photo areas are indicated by green stars on the map.
- > Campus buildings will be closed during the event.
- During all times on campus, please follow all current safety guidelines. This includes physical distancing and wearing masks when within 6 ft. of others outside of family groups.

Note: All plans have been developed based on current Multnomah County guidelines for outdoor events. If additional restrictions are in place for the date of May 8, then revisions may need to be announced.
