## **Petition for the Academic Recovery Pilot Course (Summer 2021)**

In order to participate in the Academic Recovery Pilot, whereby your completion of a summer course would return your academic standing, you are required to complete and submit this form, which includes an appeal letter that will go to the Academic Policies Committee and the Financial Aid Advisory Committee. Your participation in this opportunity will require approval of both committees before you may register for the course. **To be considered for this opportunity, you must submit your request no later than July 2.**

By University policy, students must make satisfactory progress in their course of study. Students on financial aid also fall under federal regulations, which require that Warner Pacific University monitor academic progress to ensure students: 1) remain in good academic standing, and 2) demonstrate progress toward their degree by completing satisfactorily a specified number of credits each semester. Students failing to meet the standards are ineligible to receive aid.

As indicated in correspondence from the Office of Academic Affairs and the Office of Student Financial Services, your enrollment and financial aid have been suspended. You may appeal for reconsideration of your eligibility for readmission and for financial aid by providing the information requested in this form and showing sufficient reasons for reconsideration. If you do not wish to pursue this option of a summer Academic Recovery Course, you may still appeal through the processes of each committee.

The statement regarding your unique circumstances and reasons why the Academic Policies Committee and Financial Aid Advisory Committee should consider your request for readmission and for the awarding of financial aid must include the **reasons you failed to make satisfactory academic progress, what has changed, and what will change that will allow you to make satisfactory academic progress at the end of the next term.** It should also include your level of commitment to completing a summer course focusing on the development of your academic skills and your anticipated graduation date.

**Before submitting your petition, you must acquire a signature from your academic advisor or from Academic Support Personnel** (Kimberly Love, Jonathan Manz, Kirby Gleason), to ensure they are aware of the request.
