QUALIFICATIONS

DUTIES

- Conduct research and assist in writing articles about the history and culture of Mt. Tabor Park
- Create brochures to be distributed to park visitors and used in nature programs
- Create educational tools for children, including games and activities (bingo, scavenger hunts)
- Collect and catalog scientific items (biological artifacts, equipment, photos, articles) that can be used to supplement nature programs at the Visitor's Center
- Participate in the development and implementation of nature tours within the park
- Participate in the development and implementation of stewardship events, including plantings and invasive species removal with community members.
