Transfer Guide for Portland Community College

Warner Pacific University is committed to serving students by providing clear pathways for baccalaureate degree completion. This pathway outlines a 2+2 plan for the baccalaureate degree: 2 years (or equivalent) of community college coursework plus 2 years at WPU to complete the degree.

Years 1 & 2: Complete the AAS in Exercise Science at PCC

- **Total Credits** Complete at least 90 quarter credits (60 semester credits) of transferrable coursework as part of your AAS Exercise Science curriculum

- **General Education Core**

The completed AAS in Exercise Science degree meets the following core requirements at WPU. All courses must be completed with grades of C- or higher.

- **Required Foundation Courses**

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Years 3 & 4: Courses You Will Take at Warner Pacific University

□ **Total Credits**

- Complete an additional 60 semester credits to reach 120 total semester credits
- Include at least 40 credits of upper-division courses (300-level or 400-level)

□ **Required Foundation Courses (if not already completed)**

Any of these courses that were not already taken at PCC will need to be completed at WPU:

□ **Major Courses** Complete your major at WPU by taking these courses (grades of C- or higher)
