

Prerequisites for BSN (Bachelor of Science in Nursing)

Transfer Guide for Mt Hood Community College



Warner Pacific University offers a pre-licensure BSN program that prepares students from diverse backgrounds to flourish as professional nurses. This transfer guide outlines the prerequisite coursework that students can complete at community college prior to applying to the BSN program.

Courses You Should Take at Mt Hood Community College

- **Total Credits & GPA** Complete at least 90 quarter credits (60 semester credits) of transferrable coursework. A minimum cumulative college GPA of 2.5 is required.

- **Science Prerequisite Courses for BSN Program**

Science prerequisite courses must be completed within the past seven years with a minimum grade of C- on each course. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required for these science courses. For courses taken more than once in the past seven years, the higher grade of the first two attempts will be used in the science GPA calculation.

- **Additional Prerequisite Courses for BSN Program**

Courses must be completed with a minimum grade of C- on each course.

<u>BSN Prerequisite Requirement</u>	<u>Approved MHCC Course(s)</u>
○ Math course at 100 level or above (1 course)	MTH 105 or higher
○ General Psychology (1 course)	PSY 201 or 202
○ General Sociology (1 course)	SOC 204
○ Lifespan Human Development (1 course)	PSY 237

- **General Education Core** Meet the lower-division general education core through one of these options.

Option 1: Complete the AAOT to meet the general education core

Option 2: Complete the specific general education core course requirements (grades of C- or higher) as follows:

The BSN Program at Warner Pacific University

Students admitted to the BSN program at Warner Pacific University complete of 62 credits over the span of 4 semesters (2 years). The requirements include 53 credits of Nursing coursework and 9 credits of baccalaureate-level core coursework (ILR 300 Advanced Information Literacy & Research, HUM 310 Exploring the Human Condition, and REL 320 Spirituality, Character, and Service).
