## Years 1 & 2: Courses You Should Take at Portland Community College

- □ **Total Credits** Complete at least 90 quarter credits (60 semester credits) of transferrable coursework.
- General Education Core Meet the lower-division general education core through one of these options.
  - Option 1: Complete the AAOT (Oregon) to meet the general education core OR

Option 2: Complete the specific general education core course requirements (grades of C- or higher) as follows:

- o Written Communication (2 courses)
- Health Course (1 course)

o Science (1 course)

- o PE Course (1 course)
- Hist/Cultural Knowledge (1 course)
- Ethics (1 course)
- Critical Thinking & Strat Action (1 course)
- Urban Life (1 course)
