

# B.S. in Early Childhood/Elementary Education

## Warner Pacific University 2.5-Year Degree Plan



This sample curriculum is designed to show you how a program may be constructed for a transfer student to complete the major in 2.5 years (two years of major coursework plus a semester of full-time student teaching). **This plan assumes you have successfully completed the following college-level coursework that has been approved for transfer to WPU:**

- **At least 45 semester credits of transfer credit**
- **All lower-division core requirements** for Warner Pacific University through one of the following options:
  - Successful completion of an Associate of Arts for Oregon Transfer (AAOT) degree
  - Successful completion of a Washington Direct Transfer Agreement (DTA) associate degree
  - Successful completion of all required individual courses for lower-division core

**If you lack any of these requirements, you will need to add them to your degree plan** and may require more than 2.5 years for completion. You should work with your academic advisor to design a personalized program of studies.

This program includes multiple courses that are offered every 2 years on a rotating basis. Course offerings will vary depending on the date of your entry into the program.
